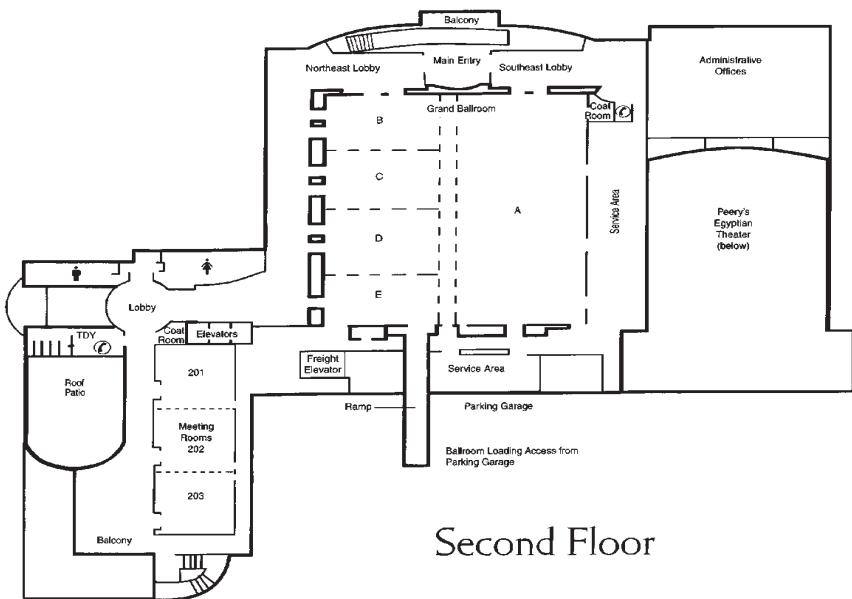
The conference will provide a highly informative and educational experience that will be of interest to all practitioners. I look forward to seeing you there.

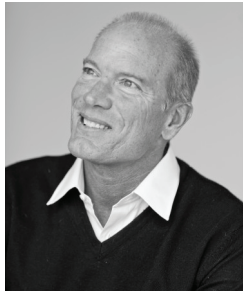

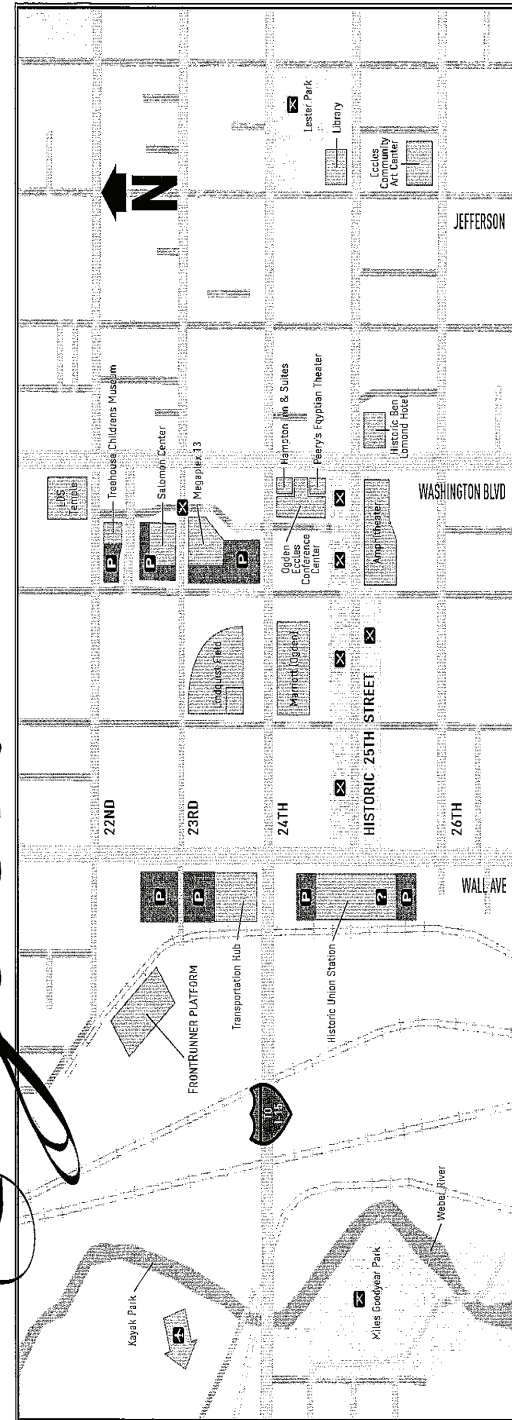

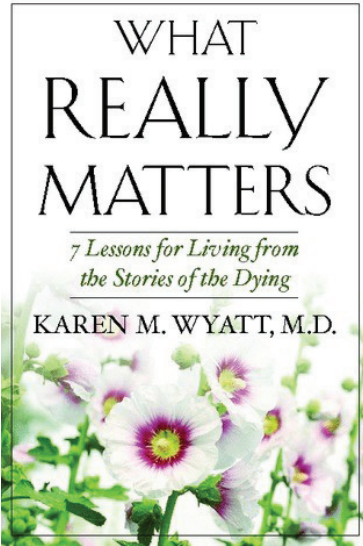


**Parking**-Free Parking is available at the Junction garage at 24th Street & Grant. It is recommended attendees park in the far southeast corner closest to the conference center.
